In his time with the senator, Denney also covered issues pertaining to agriculture, Native Americans, law enforcement, health care and telecommunications. Denney served as the Senator's chief spokesperson.

Denney also managed public affairs campaigns for a variety of government, corporate and nonprofit clients at Powell Tate/Weber Shandwick in Washington.
